



Industry Overview


Mauritania has a **750 km** coastline on the Atlantic Ocean with a **Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ)** that extends over **234,000 km²**, including a continental shelf rich in fishery resources with an area of **39,000 km²**.

The country also has vast inland water resources, including an **850 km** river bank and more than **3500 km² of floodplains** with more than **25 permanent water bodies**, mainly in the south and southeast of the country.


